2 KEY MENTOR REQUIREMENTS

1. Commitment: Facilitate 12-14, 45-minute StrengthBank® Talk Group Sessions during ABC High School's regular school term.
2. Participate in the 6 hour Mentor Certification training (also counts as professional development).

Definition: StrengthBank® is the bank of strengths which are part of the unique plan for each student's life that will not harm, that will prosper, and give hope and a future. Each student will discover and explore each one's unique StrengthBank® and examine how healthy, effective relationships become the foundation for buffeting the struggles of life positively in order to stay on course to live life's pre-designed plan or Big Time Vision - without a vision there is no hope.

Methodology: Anytown business and community leaders become volunteer mentors to high school students by attending a one-day certification seminar which enables each to mentor with the StrengthBank® Talk Groups curriculum. Talk Groups meet during high school advisory periods approximately two times per month (12-14 times in a school year) - about the time adults spend on 2 lunch breaks a month.

Confidentiality: StrengthBank® Talk Groups are confidential to the mentors, teachers and students. In order to build trust and respect, everyone commits to keeping the "talk" within the small group.

Preparation Requirements: Minimal preparation from the mentor is needed before each Talk Group. StrengthBank®-certified mentors follow a simple curriculum designed to provide relevant leadership and relationship strategies to encourage and connect into the lives of youth.

Extras: StrengthBank® Mentors are instrumental in providing not only the food for thought but also food for snacks. Mentors are encouraged to recruit local businesses to participate by providing snacks for the Talk Group sessions so StrengthBank® kids get another exposure to the local community, are given an opportunity to show gratitude, practice good manners, and witness the community's heart toward them. This is also a valuable forum for the students to understand the concept of reciprocity, those who are mentored will be more likely to turn around as an adult and give the next generation a hand up.

The "Magic" is Hope: Every teen will surrender to something as a way to order life. StrengthBank® is the long-term answer for keeping hope alive in each life, that is, for understanding struggles lead to perseverance, perseverance to character, character to Hope.

BACK TO SCHOOL MEANS ALL OF US!

Each new school year presents a unique life-changing, life-affirming opportunity to make a positive difference in teenage lives at ABC High School. - 52% less likely than their peers to skip a day of school
- 46% less likely to use drugs
- 32% less likely to physically fight
- 28% less likely to use alcohol
